

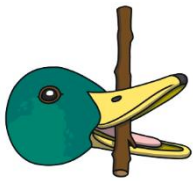
Homework

This week in phonics we have been learning the phonemes 'ck' and 'e'. Please practice these at home.

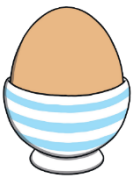
Inside your child's book bag are the grapheme practice sheets for 'ck' and 'e'.

Below are the sayings for each grapheme to support your child with the letter formation.

NB: when two letters make a single sound, such as 'ck', we call it a **digraph**.



ck - "Curl around the duck's head. Down the stick, up and around the top of the duck's beak, then flick out at the bottom of the duck's beak"



e - "Around the egg and under the cup"
