Science Day

On Tuesday, Years 5 and 6 experienced a fantastic day that was jam-packed with science. The day got off to an exciting start with a 'space' science show delivered by scientists from Cambridge University. This was followed by a space-themed workshop which involved testing a range of materials for absorbency - discovering that the most absorbent material was used to make nappies for astronauts! The children also got to use a robotic arm to move objects. Led by Miss Hayes a science teacher from Saint John Fisher School, the children then prepared a range of science experiments; lava lamps, 'tornado in a bottle', 'gloopy gloop' and more! The day ended with a 'Science Fair' in the hall for parents and lower Key Stage Two - with the children presenting and explaining their experiments.

KS1 went down to the woods today and had a great time. We had a long walk through Bretton, in the sunshine, to find a very hidden away, tranquil spot where we could have been anywhere in the UK. The children took part in 4 activities: a woodland walk, making bunting with leaf impressions, making homes for stick men and their favourite; making and baking bread on an open fire. Actually, come to think of it, I think their favourite part was the eating of the bread (which smelt lovely). The adults that worked with us from 'Nene Coppicing and crafts' were very complimentary about the children's attitude and behaviour and, as always, we were very proud of them. The children had a fabulous time and the walk back was much quieter than the way there as some of them were worn out from their adventures. Thank you to all the adults who came with us.
